

November Show & Tell

The November Show & Tell was a great example of the mix of work that our members are capable of making. Curt Vogt who has the busiest shop outside of the North pole brought in three of his fabulous Christmas ornaments. Aside from various tree woods that Curt has access to he also used sea urchin for one of the ornaments. His finishes consisted of poly and shellac, because some of the exotics that he used require don't respond well to poly.

Paul Seipel brought in a pair of grips he made for a model 1911 semi-auto handgun. In addition to molding the grips Paul even made the molds out of silicone rubber. He was planning on making a second set of grips for his son's gun, but they are going to be pink.

Kent Krueger brought in an interesting bowl that he turned. Made of a solid cap of red mallee burl the bottom was left completely natural. This however poses a mystery as even Kent forgot exactly how he held the piece without touching the bottom.

Kevin Loyd (it's fun to refer to yourself in third-person) brought in a table that he designed to fit in a small narrow space. The design requirements were to use the burl plates and that it hold a glass of wine and a dessert plate. It was made of walnut with inset maple burl plates. The entire base was done using hand planes and card scrapers as there were no flat surfaces.

Ben Furgeson brought in a solid cherry table. Made in the Shaker style this is the product of another of the Guild's successful Woodworking 102 classes. For those looking to jumpstart their woodworking or expand into a new area the Guild does have some wonderful classes like the one Ben took.

The winner of the night was John Kilron with his Maloof-styled arm chair. Made of solid cherry the chair is a beautiful addition to any living room. Thank you to all of those that brought in their projects to share with the rest of the guild. Remember everyone the Show & Tell is open to all as it helps other better understand what kinds of work we do.
